

Dear Parents,

The evening is fast approaching when we all join together to celebrate Christmas as a school community. Our annual Christmas program will take place on Wednesday, **December 18th at 7:00pm.** Students will need to report to their classrooms at 6:30pm. The classroom and church doors will not be opened in advance. It is mandatory that you stay with your child until their teacher arrives.

Dress for the performance is semi-formal Christmas attire. Boys shirts can be long or short sleeved and can be knit or button down. Vests, blazers, or sweaters are acceptable. Pants should be khaki, corduroy, or dress pants (uniform pants are an option). Sweatshirts, shorts, jeans or athletic pants are not acceptable.

Girls may wear dresses, skirts, or dress pants. The skirts and dresses must be at least fingertip length. Dresses and tops must have sleeves unless layered under a sweater or dress jacket. Dressy shoes with low or no heel are acceptable. No makeup will be permitted.

A dress rehearsal has been scheduled in the church on Tuesday, December 17 at 1:00 p.m. All are welcome to attend. Unless they are members of the cast, students will wear their uniforms to this rehearsal. Cast members will dress in costume.
